## New Features

- Organizations can now add XML and ISO-STS compliant documents into SWISS<sup>®</sup>. This process allows organizations direct control of onboarding their content into their catalog within the SWISS<sup>®</sup> library. This robust process includes a complete administrative function and user guide.
- Initial release of training videos now available within Spectacle<sup>®</sup>.
- Ability to choose 1 or 2 hops from target document when using “References to” function.

## Content

- Over 1100 standards documents were added to the SWISS<sup>®</sup> library since April 2018.

## Enhancements, Corrections, and Bug Fixes

- MIL-STD-961 compliance reports gated to applicable documents.
- Ability to see all revision of documents in SWISS<sup>®</sup> “References to” and links back to ASSIST where appropriate.
- New status indicator to alert users that interim changes are available. Interim changes to a document can now be added and removed from view through activation of an on-screen button.
- Project-specific branding for unique organization implementation of SWISS<sup>®</sup> (where applicable).
- “References from” now lists all referenced specifications to a document and provides links to external sources where available. Users can also filter the references based their status.
- “More Information” button added to reference information from window for documents where their status is not known.
- Default image size increased when selecting the image for a larger view.
